Re: Demand for Mediation

Dear Ms. Sander,

Our clients—Dr. James Studnicki, Dr. Donna J. Harrison, Tessa Longbons, Dr. Ingrid Skop, Dr. David C. Reardon, Dr. John W. Fisher, Dr. Maka Tsulukidze, Christopher Craver, Dr. Christina Cirucci, Dr. Sharon J. MacKinnon, and the Charlotte Lozier Institute (“Authors”)—hereby demand that Sage Publications, Inc. (“Sage”) and Gregory M. Garrison, M.D., Editor-in-Chief of Sage’s *Health Services Research and Managerial Epidemiology* (“Journal”) (together, “Respondents”) engage in non-binding mediation regarding Respondents’ February 5, 2024 retraction of three articles—namely, Studnicki, et al. 2021,¹ Studnicki, et al. 2019,² and Studnicki, et al. 2022.³ The mediation will also address all public statements that Respondents have made about the Authors or their work, including in their Retraction Notice, their Expression of Concern and elsewhere. *See, e.g.*, “A note from Sage on retractions in *Health Services Research and Managerial Epidemiology*,” perspectivesblog.sagepub.com (Feb. 5, 2024). It will address the removal of Dr. Studnicki from the Journal’s Editorial Board. And it will involve the Authors’ claims for all appropriate relief arising from Respondents’ improper conduct, including all appropriate monetary damages and equitable relief.

Mediation is demanded under the terms of the Publishing Agreements (“Agreements”) whereby the Authors granted Sage a license to publish the retracted articles. However, we believe the Authors and Respondents have exhausted all reasonable efforts to settle this dispute.

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
